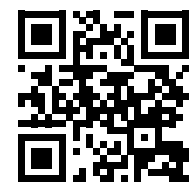

Mercy-USA Continues Gaza Feeding Program

Despite promises of peace and ceasefires, families in Gaza continue to suffer displacement, fear and hunger.

Mercy-USA has been working with our on-the-ground partner, the Agricultural & Environmental Development Society, AED on a continuous basis throughout the

entire year to provide daily hot meals to hundreds of families in Gaza.

Ceasefire Agreement Doesn't Signal an End to the Suffering in Gaza.

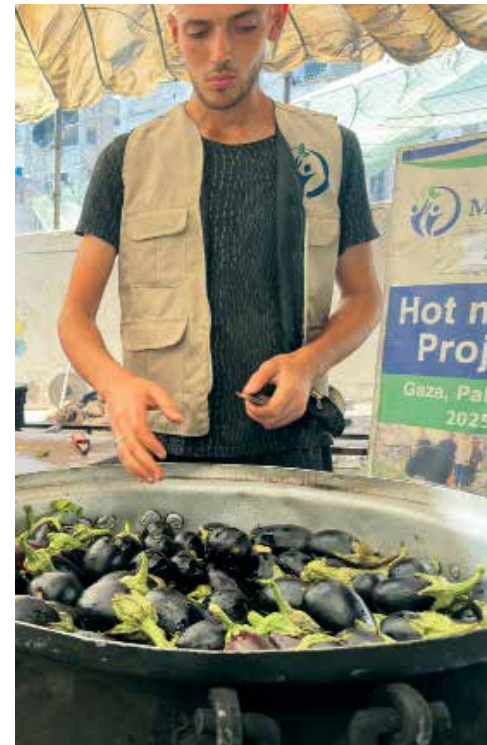

people where they are and where the need is greatest. While recent developments include an agreement to end the war on Gaza, the people who have lost their homes and their way of life may not experience much of a difference in their daily existence. Food in the marketplace is still unaffordable for most families. Mercy-USA and our partner, AED have been distributing nutritious meals every day. When possible, the team sources fresh vegetables and meat to serve with enriched pasta or lentils and rice.

Recently, the team has also distributed hot meals to children who have lost parents, and in hospitals where the conditions are very basic and food is not given.

Mercy-USA will continue to help as many people in Gaza with the generous support of our donors.





5K for Yemen

Early last summer, people, young and old, came out to run (or walk) for Yemen in a 5K race sponsored by Mercy-USA. The weather on the day in the Detroit metro area was perfect for the event.

Participants warmed up, ran 5 kilometers, enjoyed a delicious meal and finished the morning by making new friends and raising money for our Yemen food aid program benefiting families there who are struggling with food insecurity.





Yemen Food Crisis



In Marib, Taiz, Aden, and Lahj regions of Yemen, the food crisis is severe especially for people who have been displaced from their homes. Families are often not able to source enough food and have been resorting to extreme coping strategies such as skipping meals or selling off possessions just to survive. The

increasing funding gaps in the humanitarian sector combined with the continuing conflict and effects of climate change have made this crisis worse. Mercy-USA distributes monthly food baskets and water to families who have been internally displaced in the Marib, Taiz, Aden and Lahj regions.

Texas Hill Country Flood Relief

With generous financial support from our donors plus supplies donated by Muslim communities in San Antonio, and Austin, TX, Mercy-USA was able to partner with the Austin Disaster Relief Network (ADRN) to deliver essential emergency flood relief and recovery supplies directly to vulnerable households affected by the floods in Texas Hill Country. We coordinated with ADRN to deliver dehumidifiers, chainsaws, clean-up supplies plus personal protection equipment to volunteers and households hard hit by these devastating floods.
