- 8. The NGO must satisfy Mercy-USA's reporting requirements (quarterly narrative and financial reports plus final reports with copies of all specific expense/receipt documents attached) and accounting standards (accounts are current, accurate, segregated and auditable with proper receipts and bookkeeping).
